



Progress Report for November 2003 to March 2004

Since the WG1/MC meeting in Bern last November, work has concentrated on the opening workshop, which was held successfully at ESTEC, Noordwijk, the Netherlands on March 11-13, 2004. There were approximately 65 participants contributing altogether 26 talks and 27 posters. It was decided to make a special issue of ACP (Atmospheric Chemistry and Physics, the EGU journal) instead of workshop proceedings. At present, 15 authors have declared their intention to submit a paper.

Just before the workshop, the LAUTLOS radiosonde intercomparison campaign took place in Sodankyla, Finland. First results were presented at the workshop.

For the rest of the year 2004 we have planned some smaller expert meetings and an MC meeting. The expert meetings will be dedicated to (a) Lidar calibration (July, WG1), (b) analyzing the results of the LAUTLOS campaign (August, WG1), and (c) cirrus (October, WG3). The MC meeting is currently planned to take place alongside with meeting (c).
